WHAT ARE THE RISKS AND WHAT COULD I GET IN RETURN?



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product until 28 February 2022. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early

stage and you may get back less.

The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because is BCS not able to pay you. We have classified this product as 6 out of 7, which is the second-highest risk class. This classification takes into consideration two elements: 1) the market risk - that rates the potential losses from future performance at a high level; and 2) the credit risk which estimates that poor market conditions will likely impact to pay you. A risk that is materially relevant to the product but not included in the summary risk indicator is the risk that in the event the product redeems early due to an autocall, you may be unable to reinvest your money at an attractive rate.
