### 1. What is this product?



## 2. What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator



**The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for until 15 November 2022. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less. You may not be able to cash in early.**

We have classified this product as 5 out of 7, which is a medium-high risk class. This classification takes into consideration two elements: 1) the market risk - that rates the potential losses from future performance at a medium-low level; and 2) the credit risk which estimates that poor market conditions will likely impact the capacity of the issuer to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. If you will receive payments in a currency other than the official currency of the Member State where the product is marketed, the final return you will get will depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

You are entitled to receive back at least 100% all of your capital. Any amount over this, and any additional return, depends on future market performance and is uncertain. If the issuer is not able to pay you what is owed, you could lose your entire investment.

### 3. What happens if the manufacturer is unable to pay out?

The product aims to provide you with the return described under "1. What is this product?" above. However, this only applies if the product is held to maturity. It is therefore recommended that the product is held until 15 November 2022 (maturity).
